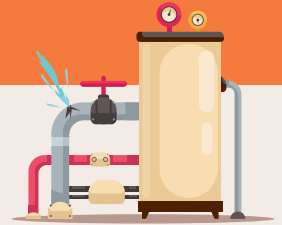

If you suspect a natural gas leak, evacuate the area immediately and from a safe location, call the number above. If you experience any issues with this number, call 911.

**Utility Control** (*Information only, always consult a professional*)

In the event that you need to turn off the electricity in your house, go to the breaker box and do the following:

1. Turn off smaller breakers one by one
2. Flip the "main" breaker last
  - a. To re-energize your home, reverse the steps above.

In the event you need to shut water off inside your home, do the following:

1. Find the main water valve and turn it to your right.
  - a. To open the flow of water back into the house, turn it to your left.

Only turn off the gas at the meter if you smell gas! To turn off natural gas in your house, do the following:

1. Take a wrench and tighten it on to the quarter turn valve that is on the pipe that feeds into the gas meter.
2. Turn it one-quarter turn to make the indicator parallel to the ground.
  - a. In most locations, once you do this you cannot turn the gas back on to the house without the utility company.

If you live in an area that uses outdoor propane or LPG you will find this outside the home, do the following:

1. Open the top of the tank and you will see either a regular turn knob or a quarter turn valve. Turn the knob to your right to shut off the flow of propane into your house.
