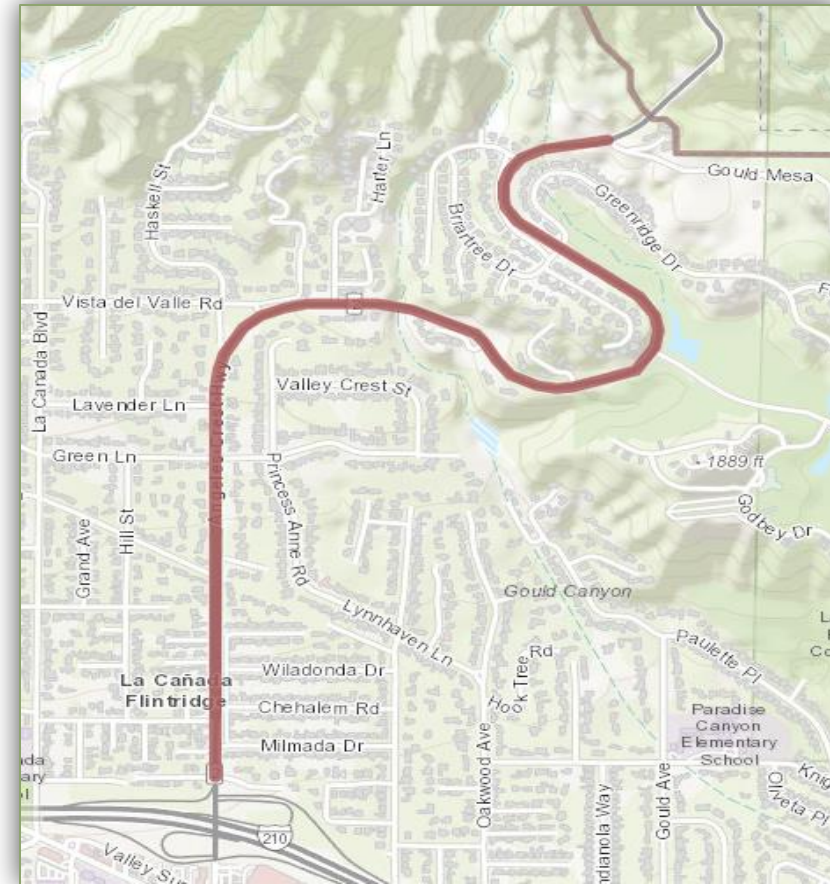

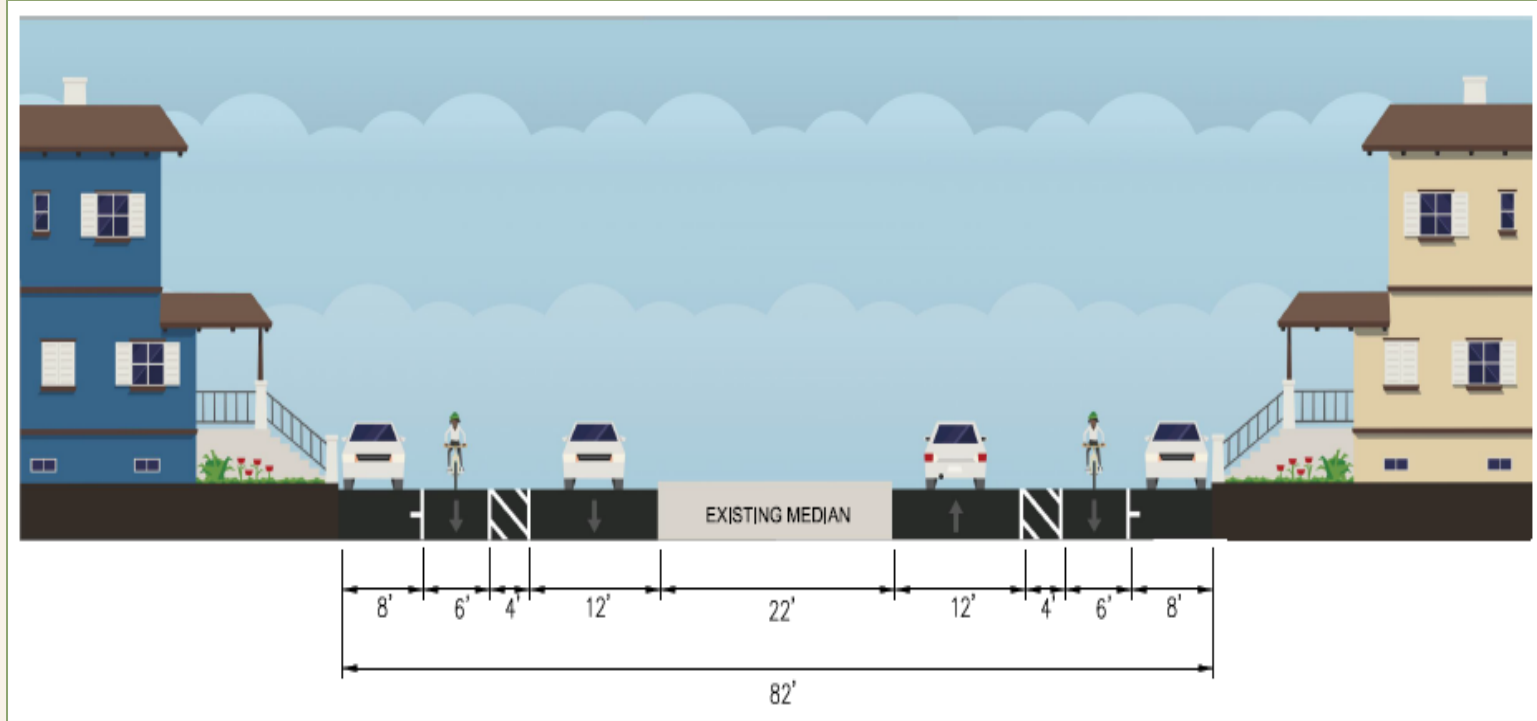
Design Elements

- Traffic Signal
- Road Diet (one lane of travel)
- Medians
- Bike Lane
- Parking Lane
- Sidewalk



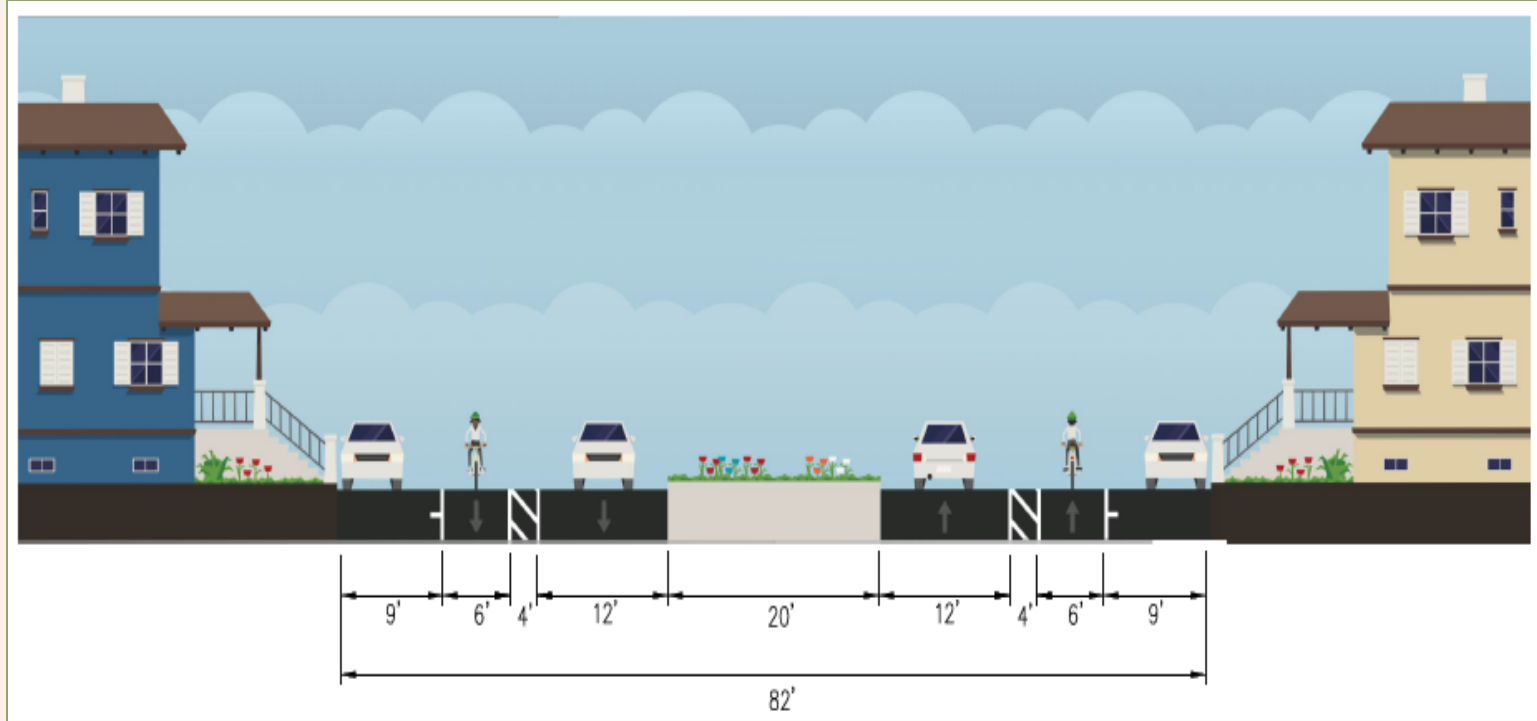
Option 1

Traffic Signal	✓	Green Lane
Median	✓	22' Existing
Travel Lane	(1) NB (1) SB	12' each
Parking Lane	✓	8'
Bike Lane	✓	6' Bike + 4' Buffer
Sidewalk		



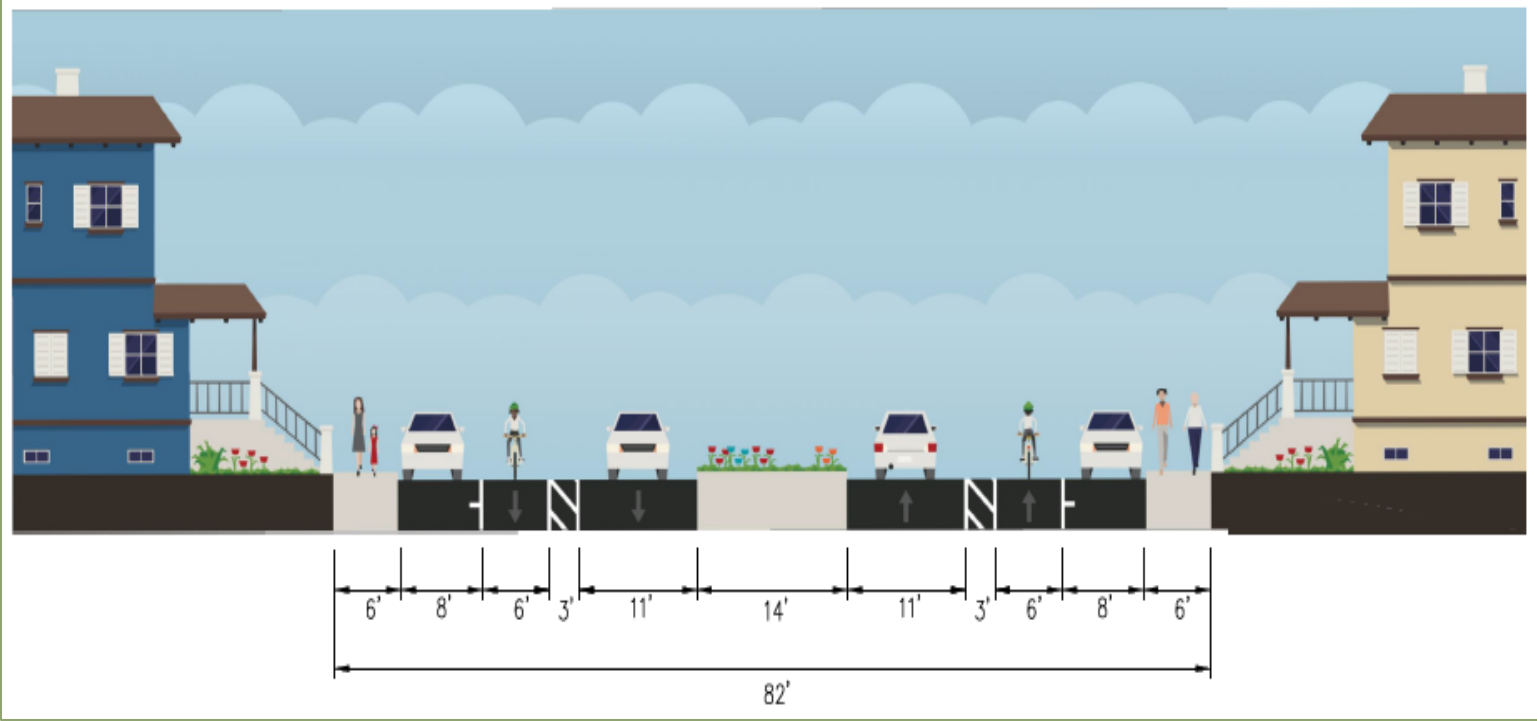
Option 2

Traffic Signal	✓	Green Lane
Median	✓	20' Landscaped
Travel Lane	(1) NB (1) SB	12' each
Parking Lane	✓	9'
Bike Lane	✓	6' Bike + 4' Buffer
Sidewalk		



Option 3

Traffic Signal	✓	Green Lane
Median	✓	14' Landscaped
Travel Lane	(1) NB (1) SB	11' each
Parking Lane	✓	8'
Bike Lane	✓	6' Bike + 3' Buffer
Sidewalk	✓	6'

Begin Construction: July 2025

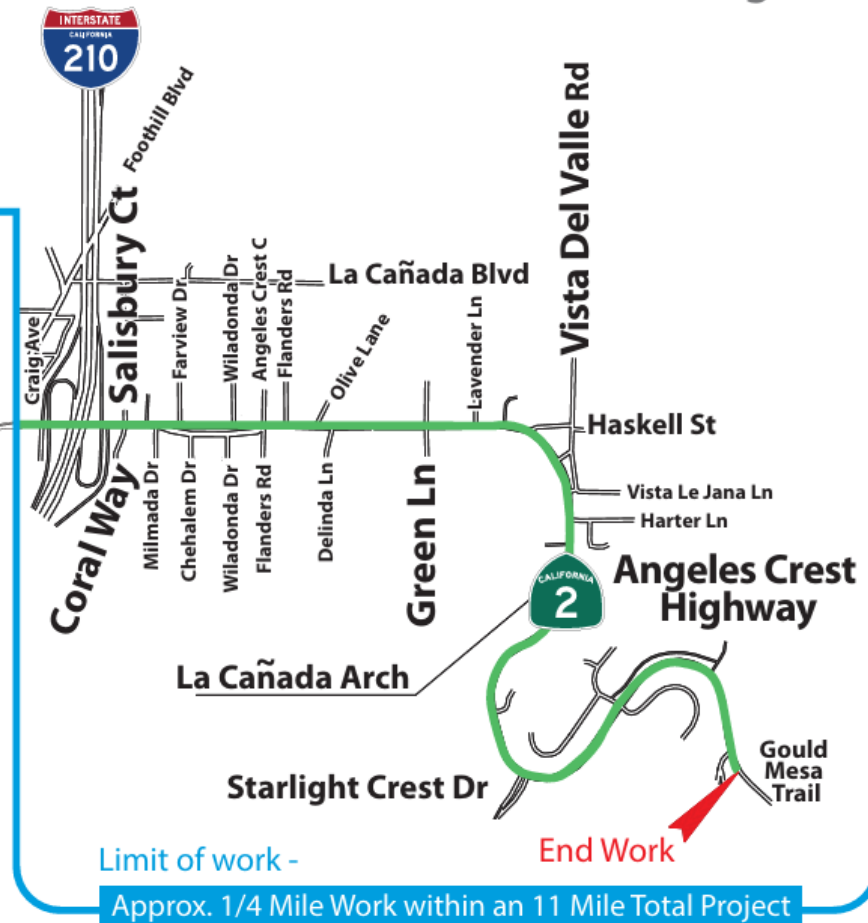
End Construction: November 2027

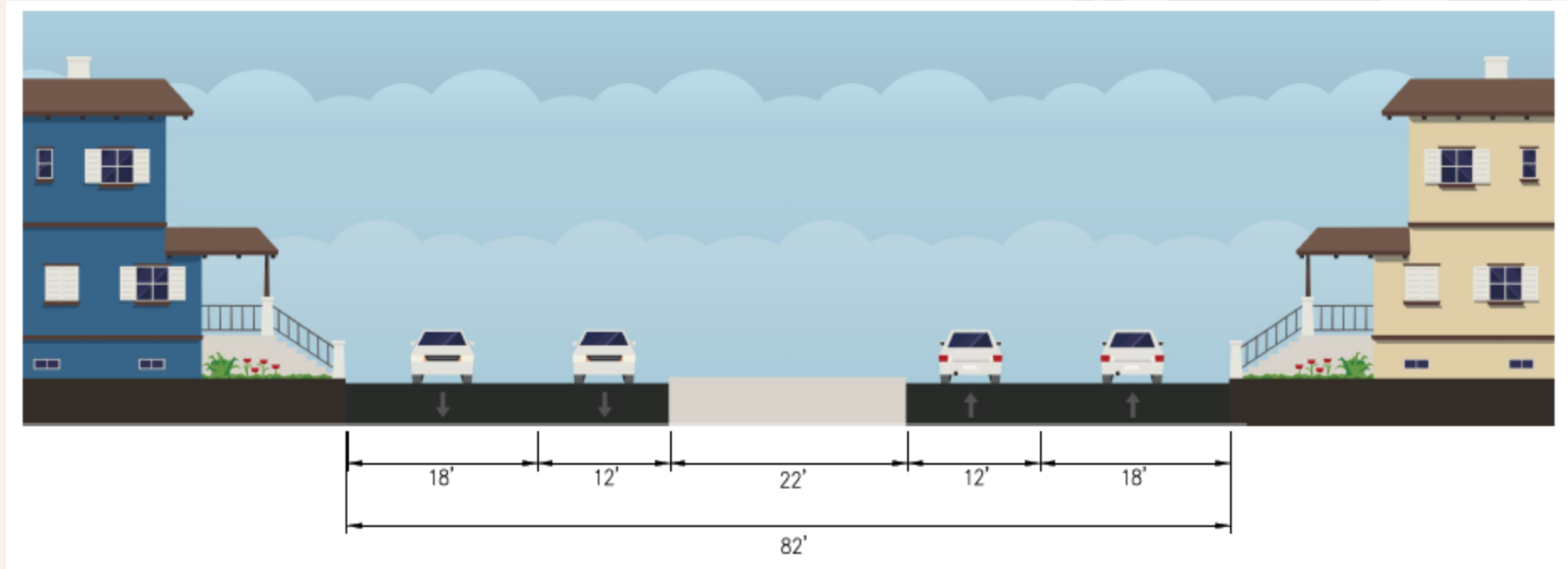

Existing Cross Section

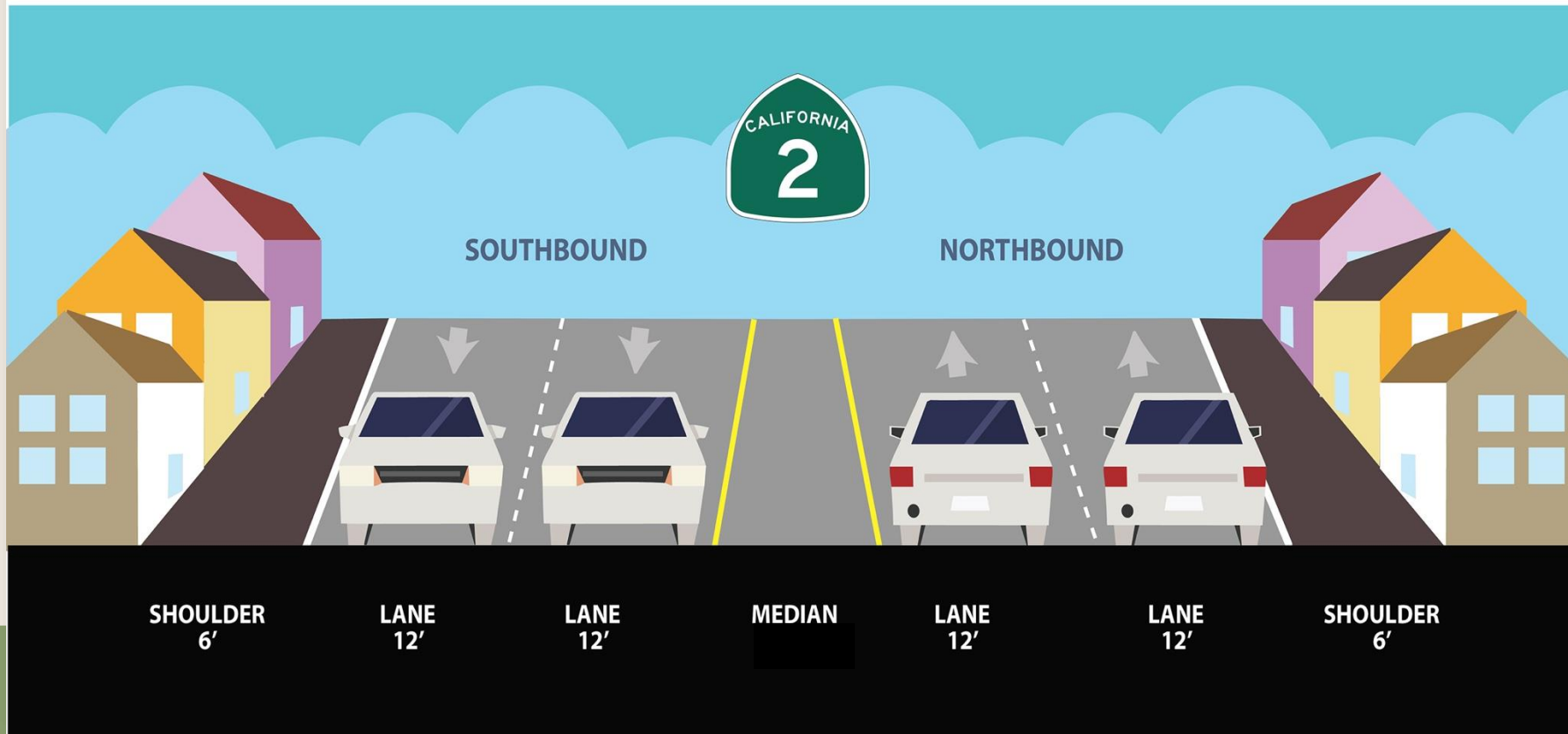


Proposed Cross Section



CORAL WAY/SALISBURY Ct. TO EAST OF LA CAÑADA ARCH

- Two Standard 12-Foot Travel Lanes in Each Direction (Unchanged)
- Existing Striped Median (Retained)
- New Dedicated 6-Foot Shoulder Along SB for Safe Vehicle Backing up onto Angeles Crest Highway
