Overview of CPA

Community Choice Aggregation (CCA)

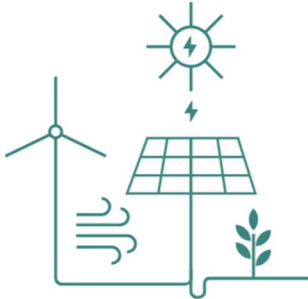
- ⚡ Enacted in California in 2002 with the passage of Assembly Bill 117.
- ⚡ Authorized local governments to aggregate the electrical load of their residents and businesses and purchase electricity on their behalf.
- ⚡ Why CCA?
 - ⚡ Consumer choice
 - ⚡ Local control, transparency & accountability
 - ⚡ Tool to help communities reach their climate goals
 - ⚡ Revenues reinvested in the community, not distributed to shareholders
 - ⚡ Development of new renewable energy projects (CCAs have driven over 18,000 MW of new-build clean energy development in CA)
- ⚡ CPA is the largest of 25 CCA's in California



We work together to bring you access to the most sustainable energy available

- ⚡ CPA purchases clean renewable power, and Southern California Edison delivers it.
- ⚡ SCE sends a single monthly bill, which includes SCE charges for electricity delivery and CPA charges for electricity supply/generation.
- ⚡ The CPA charge is NOT an added fee. It simply replaces the SCE supply/generation charge on the bill.

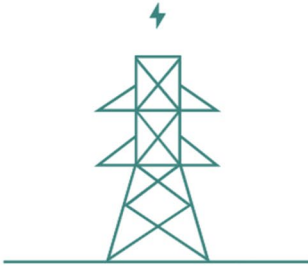

Rates

CPA's Three Rate Options



100% Green Power

- Provides 100% renewable energy content at a 5% total bill premium to SCE's base rate
- 68% of customers



Clean Power

- Provides 50% clean energy content at parity to SCE's base rate
- 21% of customers



Lean Power

- Provides 40% clean energy content at the lowest cost (1% less than SCE's base rate on a total bill basis)
- 11% of customers

Customers always have the option to change their rate, or opt-out to stay/return to SCE for both generation and delivery

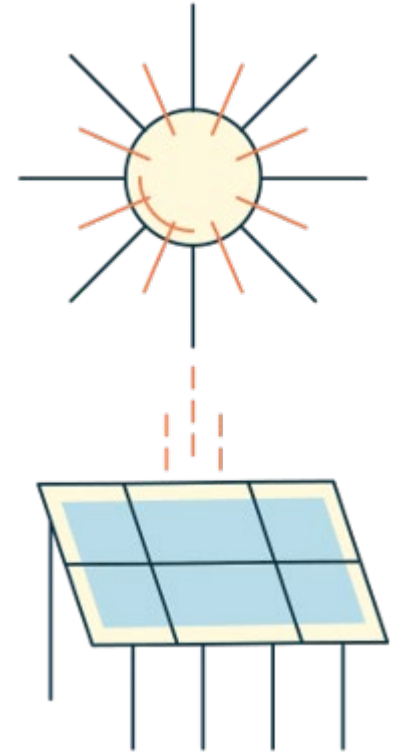

Rooftop Solar

Net Energy Metering (NEM) and Solar Billing Plan (SBP)

- ⚡ Clean Power Alliance customers with rooftop solar panels or other generating systems can receive bill credits that offset energy charges and get cash back when they generate more power than they use in a year.
- ⚡ If you have solar panels at your home or business that were approved by SCE on or before April 14, 2023, you will retain your legacy status and will be enrolled in CPA's and SCE's Net Energy Metering (NEM) programs for the duration of your 20-year legacy period.
- ⚡ Solar systems installed after April 14, 2023 will be served on SCE's and CPA's Solar Billing Plan (SBP) program
- ⚡ Clean Power Alliance calculates and applies NEM/SBP credits/charges on the generation portion of your bill.
- ⚡ SCE calculates and applies NEM/SBP credits/charges on the delivery side of your bill.
- ⚡ Current SCE NEM/SBP customers will transition to CPA NEM/SBP after they complete their 12-month billing cycle (true up or settlement bill)

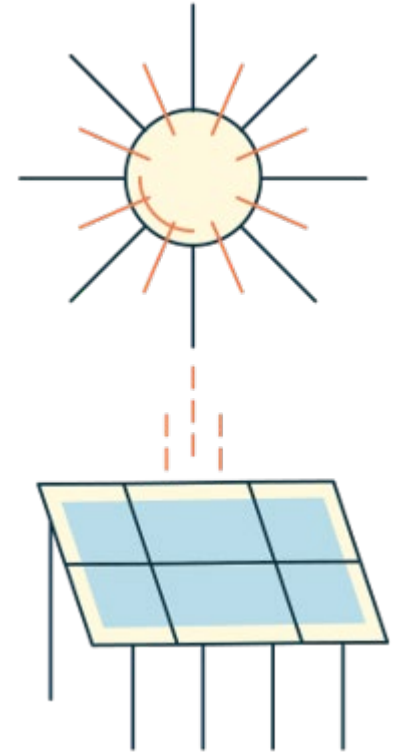

Rooftop Solar

Net Energy Metering (NEM) and Solar Billing Plan (SBP)

- There are a few small, administrative differences between how Clean Power Alliance and SCE administer the NEM/SBP program
- CPA requires monthly billing; net credits and charges settled on a monthly basis
- Annual True up (settlement bill) in April of each year
- Customers will continue to receive an annual SCE settlement for NEM/SBP delivery credits/charges
- CPA offers a compensation rate for net surplus over the course of the year that is always 10% higher than SCE's compensation rate

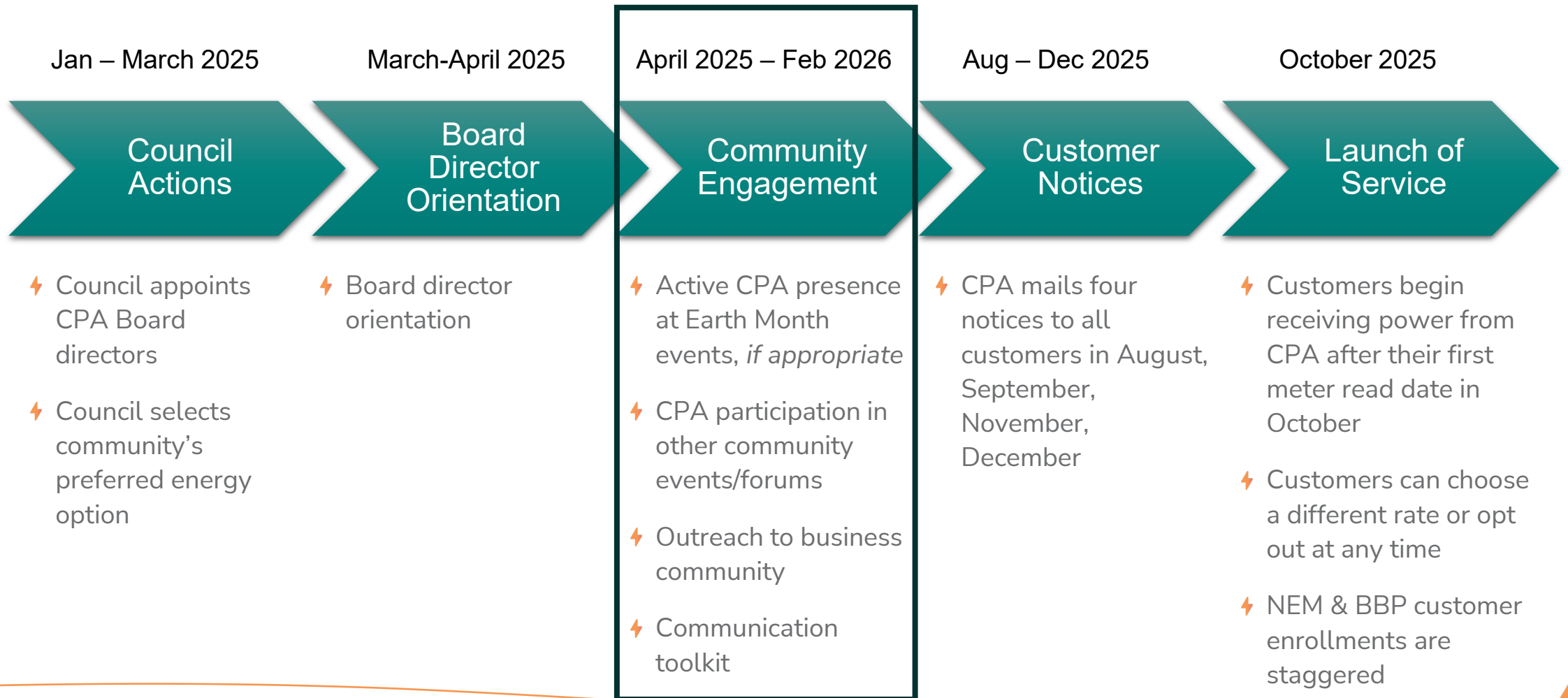
Bill Assistance

Direct Mail Notifications

Customers in LCF will receive co-branded postcards in Aug, Sept, Nov, and Dec 2025

- ⚡ **August and September:** one postcard each month will announce CPA as the customer's new electricity/clean energy provider and will highlight the community and environmental benefits to LCF while explaining the difference in cost on an average bill.
- ⚡ **November and December:** one postcard each month will thank residents for helping LCF be a Clean Power community and remind them of their enrollment in CPA.
- ⚡ All postcards will provide residents with clear directions on how to choose another energy option or opt out of CPA service if they choose.

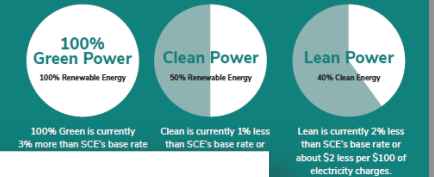

The City of Santa Paula has selected Clean Power Alliance (CPA) as your new electricity provider. Starting March 2024, your home and/or business will automatically receive clean, competitively priced energy from CPA.

How does this work?

The City of Santa Paula chose to offer you new clean energy options through Clean Power Alliance (CPA) and selected 100% Green Power as its preferred energy option.

- In March 2024, you will automatically begin receiving electricity purchased by CPA that has high levels of renewable energy and is competitively priced with Southern California Edison (SCE).
- SCE will still deliver the electricity to your home or business and send your monthly bill. Starting with your first bill in April, your power generation charges will be for CPA's purchase of energy on your behalf instead of the current power generation costs charged by SCE.
- CPA is not an extra charge on your bill but simply replaces your previous generation charge from SCE.

What are my choices?

If you do nothing, you will continue at Santa Paula's preferred energy option of 100% Green Power. Want a difference energy choice? No problem. You can change your selection at any time by choosing one of Clean Power Alliance's two other energy choices: Clean Power (with 50% renewable energy) or Lean Power (with 40% clean energy), CPA's most affordable energy option.

We hope you will stay with CPA, but you can also opt out and stay with SCE by visiting CleanPowerAlliance.org or calling us at 888-585-3788.

What will it cost?

Clean Power Alliance offers high levels of renewable energy content at competitive rates.

For residents and small/medium businesses, on a total average monthly bill basis per energy option, 100% Green Power is currently 3% more than SCE's base rate or about \$3 per \$100 of electricity charges, for approximately three times the amount of renewable energy; Clean Power is about 1% less than SCE (\$1 less); and Lean Power is about 2% less than SCE (\$2 less). Large commercial account customers should contact CPA for information about your rate.

The City of La Cañada Flintridge has selected Clean Power Alliance (CPA) as its new preferred electricity provider. Starting in October 2025, homes and businesses will transition to CPA service and automatically receive clean, competitively priced energy from CPA.

The City of La Cañada Flintridge selected 100% Green Power with 100% renewable energy as its preferred energy option, making your community cleaner and more sustainable for years to come.

Choosing **100% GREEN POWER** helps La Cañada Flintridge avoid more than 105 million pounds of harmful greenhouse gas emissions each year, which is like taking more than 11,100 gasoline-powered cars off the road annually or planting and growing 789,000 trees for a decade.

CPA is the nation's leader in providing renewable energy and serves as the local not for profit electricity provider to more than three million residents and businesses in 38 Southern California communities across Los Angeles and Ventura counties. CPA was founded in 2017 and formed as a community choice aggregator (CCA) to give communities local control and choices in their energy selection. We are different from investor-owned utilities. CPA is a locally governed by a board of directors comprised of elected officials representing every city and county we serve to best meet the diverse needs of our customers.

What does this mean for you and your electricity bill?
Residents and businesses in the city of La Cañada Flintridge will automatically transition to CPA service and 100% Green Power starting in October 2025.

Southern California Edison (SCE) will continue to send your monthly bill and deliver electricity to your home and/or business. Starting with your first bill in November, you will see charges for electricity supply/generation from CPA on your monthly electricity bill for the renewable energy purchased on your behalf. This is not an added fee or duplicate charge; the CPA charge simply replaces the SCE supply/generation charge from your previous SCE bills. CPA typically accounts for between one-third to one-half of your total electricity bill.

Because renewable energy costs a little bit more, a typical bill for residents and small businesses on 100% Green Power will go up approximately 5% or about \$5 per \$100 of electricity use charges.

Do you have a choice? Yes!
At any time customers may choose one of CPA's two other energy options - Clean Power (with 50% clean energy) or Lean Power (with 40% clean energy), our lowest priced energy option, or opt out from CPA service and stay with SCE as your electricity provider.

If you want to select another CPA energy option, stay with SCE, or compare the cost of electricity bills, we are here to help.

Santa Paula Frequently Asked Questions

Why should I switch to CPA?
CPA is committed to keeping our rates competitive and making clean energy accessible and affordable for everyone.

CPA's energy options include:
100% GREEN POWER (100% renewable energy): 100% Green is currently 3% more than SCE's base rate or about \$3 more per \$100 of electricity charges for approximately three times the amount of renewable energy.
CLEAN POWER (50% renewable energy): Clean is currently 1% less than SCE's base rate or \$1 less per \$100 of electricity charges.
LEAN POWER (40% clean energy): Lean, CPA's least expensive option, is currently 2% less than SCE's base rate or \$2 less per \$100 of electricity charges.

Comparisons are based on total average monthly bills, including generation, delivery, and surcharges at current CPA and SCE rates. Rates are subject to change. Large commercial account customers should contact CPA for information about your rates.

You can always switch between CPA energy options or you can opt out of CPA service at any time by contacting CPA. CPA does not charge any fees to opt out of service. We hope you will stay with CPA on 100% Green Power or another CPA energy option that suits you. If you opt out after CPA service has launched, SCE may charge you a one-time account processing fee and you may be prevented from returning to Clean Power Alliance for a minimum of 12 months. By opting out, you will also be subject to SCE's current rates and terms and conditions of service, which are subject to change.

How can I save money? I cannot afford a rate increase.
CPA offers three energy options: 100% Green Power, Clean Power, and Lean Power. If you're looking for the lowest price, Lean Power is your least expensive option, currently providing a 2% total bill discount compared to SCE. If you are enrolled in CARE, FERA, or Medical Baseline, you will automatically receive 100% Green Power at a 1% total bill discount to SCE in addition to your existing discounts, which will continue with CPA.

You may qualify for a customer assistance program that can help you manage your electricity bill. To learn more, visit CleanPowerAlliance.org/CPAbillhelp.

Will 100% Green Power affect the reliability of my power supply?
No. Clean Power Alliance buys and puts on the electricity grid an amount of renewable energy sufficient to meet the demand of our customers on an annual basis. The California Independent Systems Operator (CAISO) maintains the state's grid to ensure reliability of electricity on a 24/7 basis. To support grid reliability and the high levels of renewable energy demand from our customers, CPA is a leader in investing in energy storage, which can discharge renewable energy during the evening. We also invest in 24/7 renewable resources such as geothermal energy.

I have rooftop solar! I'm thinking about getting rooftop solar. How does that work with CPA?
If you already have rooftop solar, thank you for helping make our electricity grid cleaner and greener! Enrollment of your Net Energy Metering (NEM) account with CPA will be deferred until the end of your current SCE NEM relevant period. Once your account is enrolled with CPA, CPA will provide your NEM generation charges and credits, and will provide Net Surplus Compensation at a rate that is 10% higher than SCE's. If you are a new solar customer, you will be enrolled in CPA's new Solar Billing Plan. Either way, being with CPA will ensure that your home or business is powered by 100% renewable energy even when your solar panels aren't generating electricity.

As a business owner on 100% Green Power can I become a Green Leader?
Commercial account customers on 100% Green Power may be eligible to join CPA's Green Leader program. Green Leader recognizes your environmental leadership and celebrates your commitment to a clean energy future through features on CPA's website, social media, and newsletter. 

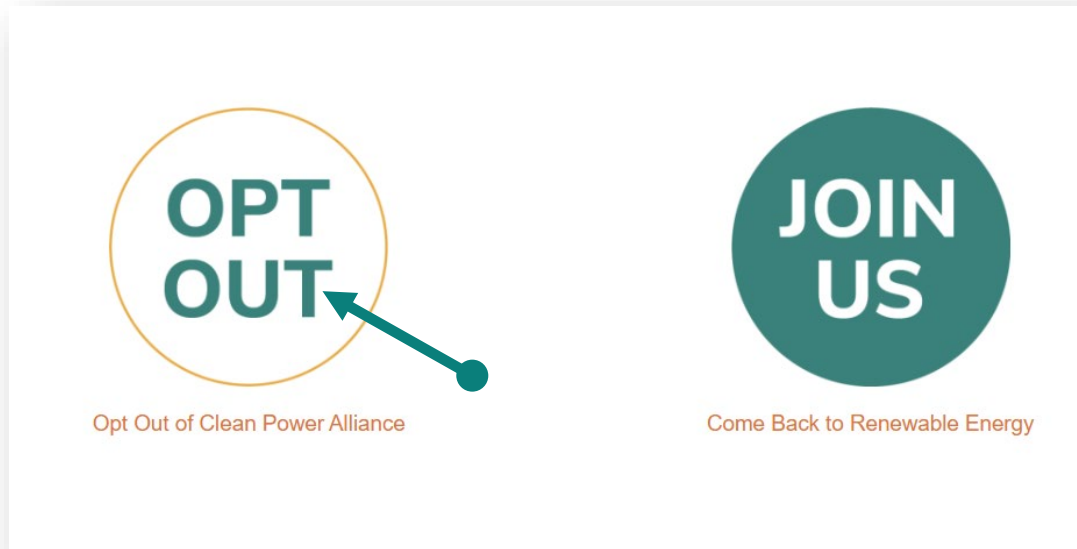

Opt Out Instructions

Clean Power Alliance is proud to bring clean, renewable power choices to communities across Los Angeles and Ventura Counties. However, if you would like to opt out of Clean Power Alliance and remain with Southern California Edison (SCE) for your power generation service, you can opt-out by entering your SCE account number (without dashes) below or by calling us at 888-585-3788.

The opt out process depends on when your service with Clean Power Alliance started. If you don't know what your service start date was, [contact us](#).

If you started service within the last 60 days

If you started service over 60 days ago

Customers who opt out of Clean Power Alliance (CPA) within their first 60 days of service may return to Southern California Edison (SCE) on their next meter read date following five business days from their request. Customers who opt out of CPA within 60 days of starting service will not be eligible to return to CPA for twelve months per SCE requirements.

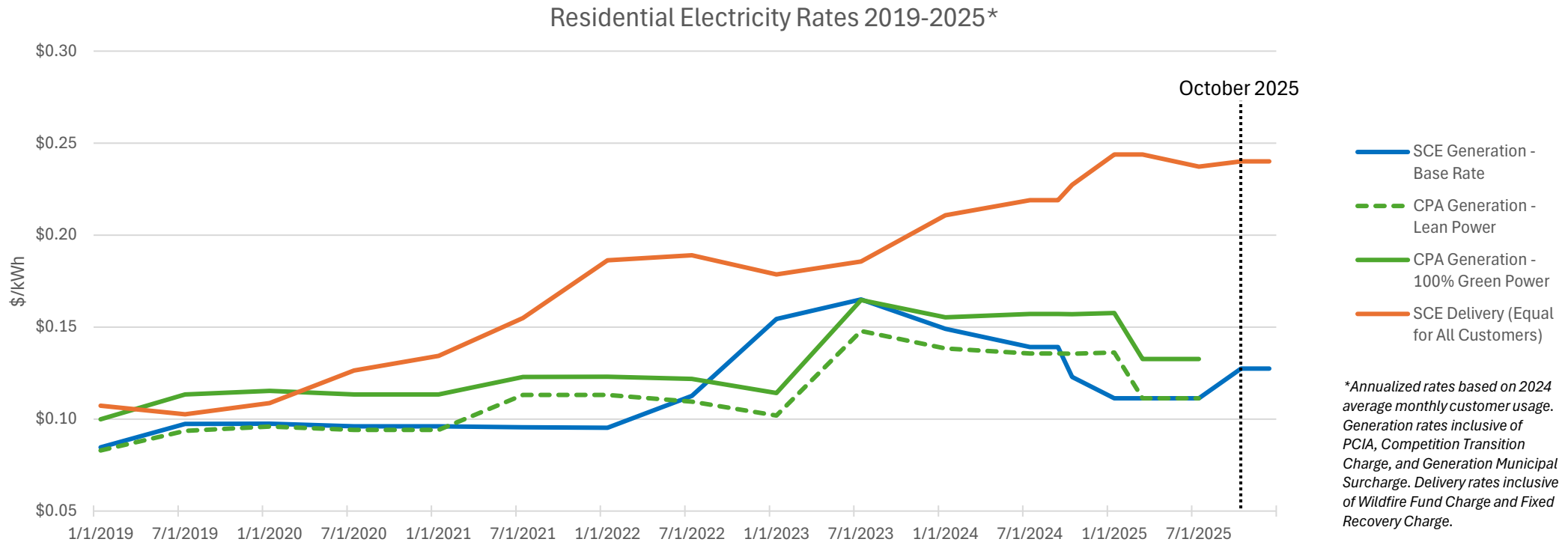
